Montrose mayor pro tem appointed as CML Policy Committee chair

Sept. 8, 2021 – Denver - City of Montrose Mayor Pro Tem Dave Frank was selected by CML Executive Board President Kathi Meyer, Steamboat Springs councilmember, to chair the Colorado Municipal League's Policy Committee. The term begins immediately and lasts through June 2022.

Frank said, "I am very honored to serve this important committee as chair, and look forward to working more closely with the outstanding staff at CML."

With over 125 members, both elected officials and staff, representing municipalities and municipal professionals around the state, the CML Policy Committee is the primary policy-making body for the League. Position recommendations on issues and legislation taken by the Policy Committee are sent to the CML Board, which will set CML's legislative agenda and official League positions. The Policy Committee is also responsible for recommending changes to the annual policy statement, which are voted on by the full membership each year at the Annual Business Meeting.
