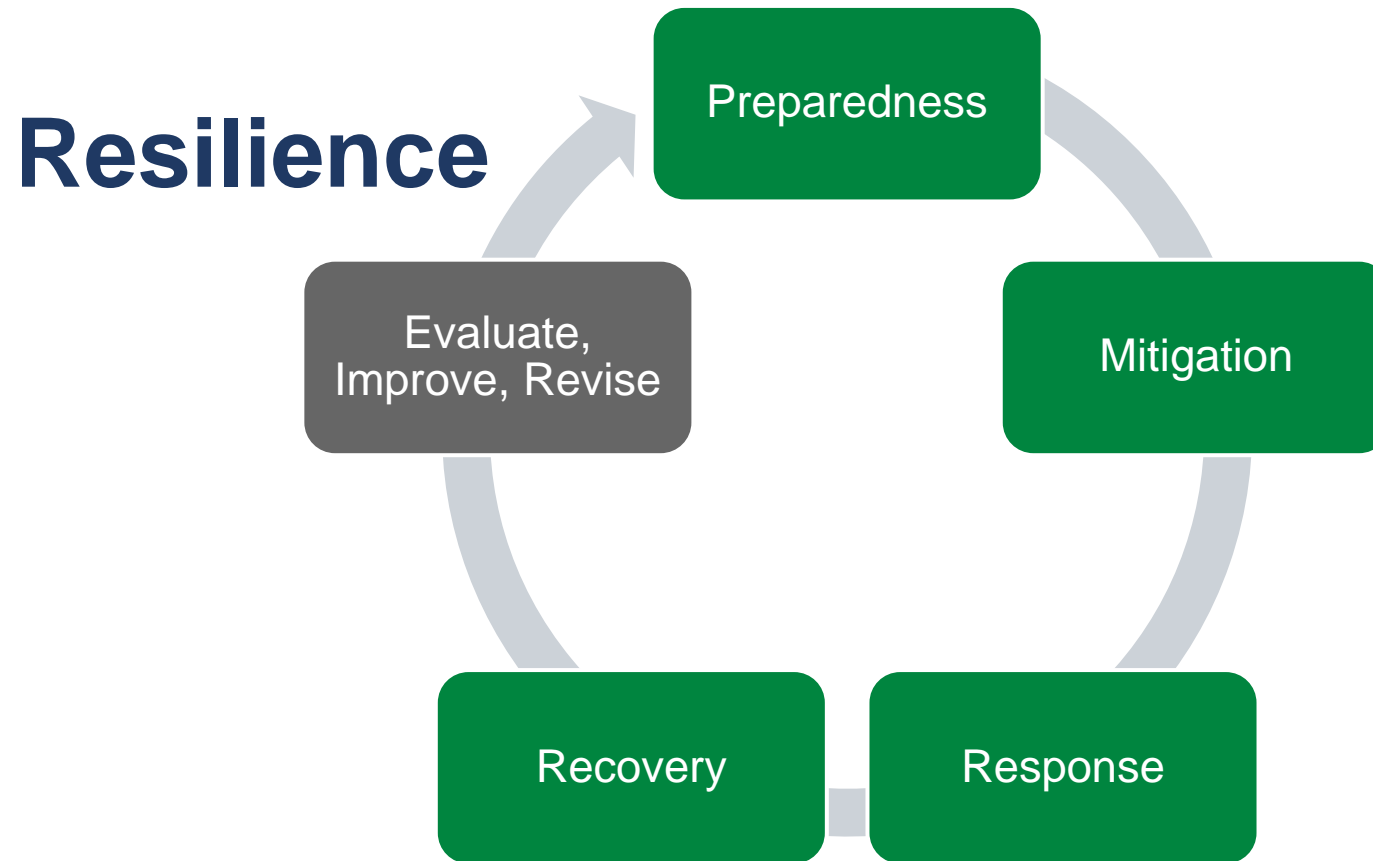

- Most costly wildfire in CO history
- Largest disaster Louisville has ever faced
- 549 Homes Lost in Louisville (single-family & multi-family)
- >\$35M

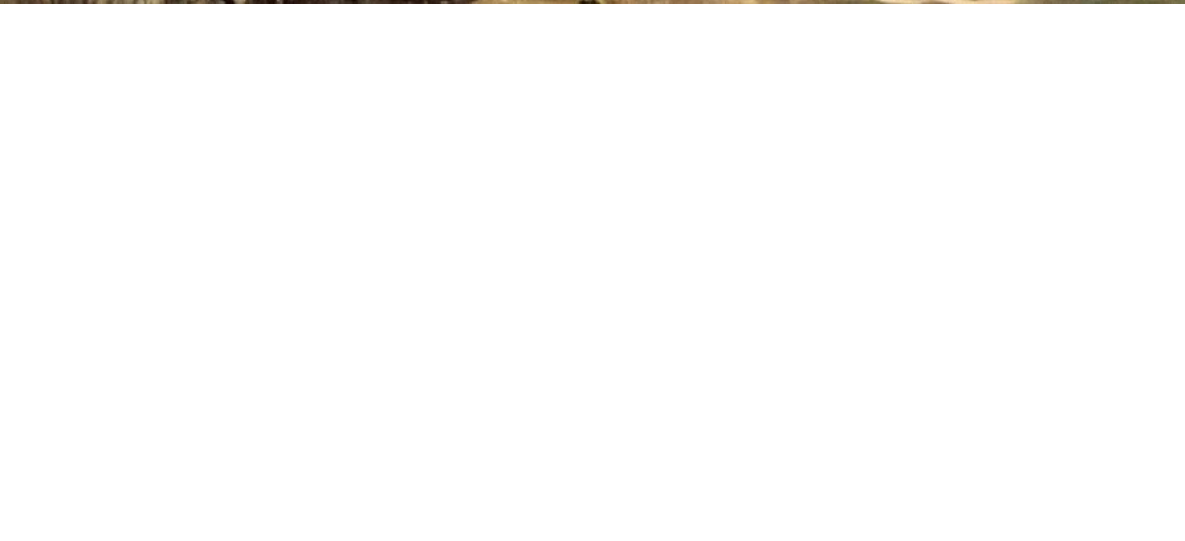

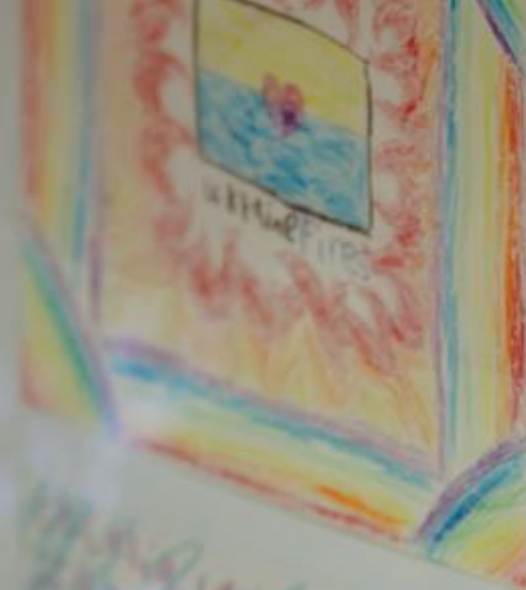
